

## Amendment to the Operating Procedures (4.2.2.9)

### *Associate Members of the Joint Committee on Standards for Educational Evaluation.*

Associate members will

- Be selected on the basis of expertise, interest, and ability to further the work of a committee or task force
- Be or be willing to become a member of one of the member organizations for the Joint Committee
- Receive an invitation (copied to the chair of the Joint Committee) from a task force or committee chair
- Normally be appointed for a one year term, renewable by the committee or task force chair
- Once recognized by the chair of the Joint Committee, be invited to be a nonvoting participant at the annual meeting and contribute to discussions
- Receive from the chair of the Joint Committee a letter of recognition for their contributions to the Joint Committee

### Rationale

With the increasing diversity of projects being undertaken by the Joint Committee, chairs of its committees and task forces may benefit from the interest, expertise, and participation of additional members from the education community in undertaking their work. Associate membership is also a vehicle through which the Joint Committee may provide an introduction to its agenda and procedures to those interested in the Committee.
