

### **Announce Four-Year Project**

A new four-year nationwide project to develop guidelines and standards for educational evaluation is based at the Evaluation Center in the University's College of Education. Dr. Daniel L. Stufflebeam, professor of educational leadership, has been named director of the project and chairman of a national Joint Committee on Guidelines and Standards for Educational Evaluation. The committee was recently awarded a \$90,690 first-year, two-part grant by Lilly Endowment, Inc., a private national foundation.

Under a subcontract made with the committee through the American Educational Research Association (AERA), the Evaluation Center will administer the project and work toward two major end products: (1) a companion volume to the "Standards for Educational and Psychological Tests" by the AERA, American Psychological Association (APA), and National Council on Measurement in Education (NCME); (2) a plan for periodic review and revision of the evaluation standards.
